Saint Oral Report Guide

You may be thinking to yourself, "Great, another dumb report!" But, this is a declaration, not a paper. In this declaration, you are choosing which Saint you want to be your spiritual guide for the rest of your life!

This Saint will become your lifelong friend and companion in a very special way. A person's Confirmation Saint always holds a special place in the eyes of God when they beseech Him on their Confirmandi's behalf. For this reason, it is important to choose someone that you can identify with or want to strive to imitate in life. If you make a good effort in picking your Saint, you will be amazed at the fruit it will reap you later in life.

As you are preparing yourself for your presentation, please keep in mind the following points. In your Saint presentation, you should:

- State the name of your Saint.
- Make a visual aid with a picture of your Saint on it.
- Explain who the Saint was by giving at least two facts about their life.
- Explain why this person is worthy of the title of Sainthood. How did their life reflect a deep relationship with God?
- Explain why you picked the Saint you did for Confirmation and what you admire about them the most.
- Explain how you plan to try and live your life in emulation of your Saint.

Your presentation should be three minutes in length. The copy you hand in should be typed and **NOT** handwritten. Also, please remember that if you want the presentation to be interesting to both yourself and the class you **SHOULD NOT**:

- Wait until last minute, giving it little to no thought
- Plagiarize your declaration from any source.
- Turn in your project late.
